

Selected students will prerecord a short pitch which will be presented to a panel of judges during the webinar. Following the pitch, judges will do a live q&a session with the presenter. The students will get to participate in a focused mentoring session where they will learn how to promote themselves and their research.

The pitch should focus on an idea which could be immediately translated into a product. It could be based on research currently being done or a novel nanoscience idea the student would like to pursue. To apply, a written (max 300 words) pitch will be submitted which includes the title, product idea, targeted market, and a description of the product and how it works.

Students will be selected based on their written submission, due Aug 14. Finalists will be notified August 21. Please submit all applications, as well as any questions, to NanoFlorida2020@miami.edu.
